

- Washington Adventist Hospital's current campus in Takoma Park is crowded, difficult to access and lacks adequate space for outpatient services. The hospital facility is aging, inefficient, has few private rooms and lacks adequate space for clinical services.
- The new location, approximately six miles from the current campus, is in the heart of the hospital's primary service area with major interconnecting roads, making it more central and more accessible.
- The new campus will consist of a main hospital building, an ambulatory care building, a proposed faith center, two medical office buildings, and two parking structures organized on the site with views of an existing lake. Site parking for bicycles will be provided.
- The hospital will have private rooms, state-of-the-art equipment and technology and more space for clinical services, including cardiac care, emergency medicine, oncology services, behavioral health care and other medical services.
- It will have the same number of beds that exist at the current facility.
- The new design will incorporate enhanced patient safety and improved visitor and patient access throughout the facility.
- The ambulatory care building will house outpatient departments and a conference center.
- The Faith Center will house worship, counseling, and education activities.
- Two free-standing medical office buildings (MOBs) on the site will be used by individual healthcare providers and for outpatient services.
- The site is organized to separate the patient/visitor entrance from the service/employee/ambulance entrance providing easy access and safety for all. A dedicated entrance is reserved for the emergency department.
- The building and landscape designs are influenced by Washington Adventist Hospital's faith-based healing mission. They take inspiration from the natural features of the site.
- The buildings will be designed to comply with applicable Montgomery County green building requirements.
- The combined relocation of the hospital and reuse of the Takoma Park campus for health-care and community services is part of Washington Adventist Hospital's Vision for Expanded Access ([www.expandedhealthaccess.com](http://www.expandedhealthaccess.com)), a multi-part initiative designed to improve the hospital's ability to meet the needs of the community.
