

APPLICATION FOR PROPOFOL PRIVILEGES

Medical staff of Shady Grove Adventist Hospital may obtain and maintain privileges to administer propofol by fulfilling the following criteria approved by the Medical Executive Committee.

Appointment type:

- Initial credentialing for propofol
- Recredentialing

Initial Competency Requirements for Propofol Privileges:

1. Active Medical Staff privileges in Emergency Medicine
2. Evidence of having Moderate Sedation Privileges
3. Completion of an Emergency Medicine residency program within the last (2) years that includes a formalized education component on the safe administration of propofol sedation (letter from the residency director required).

OR

- Evidence of at least five (5) sedations using propofol within the last two years along with evidence of satisfactory outcomes (letter from department chair will suffice).
4. _____ Physician attests that he/she has reviewed the Shady Grove Medical Center Policy on Propofol (Please initial)
 5. Score \geq 80% on the Shady Grove Medical Center Propofol Test. Score: _____ Date of test: _____
 6. Once a physician is credentialed according to the above criteria, focused peer evaluation will be conducted on their first three propofol sedations.

Ongoing Competency Requirements for Propofol Privileges:

1. Active Medical Staff privileges in Emergency Medicine
2. Evidence of having Moderate Sedation Privileges
3. Evidence of at least five (5) sedations during the previous two years with satisfactory outcomes as documented in the physician's OPPE.
4. _____ Physician attests that he/she has reviewed the Shady Grove Medical Center Policy on Propofol (Please initial)

If physician does not meet on-going competency requirements, then physician must complete initial competency requirements in order to obtain privileges.
